



To Whom It May Concern,

I am writing to formally object to the DART+ Coastal North Railway Order that proposes extending DART services from Malahide to Drogheda. While the project aims to improve public transportation, it raises significant concerns that could adversely affect residents and commuters in the Howth and surrounding areas.

- 1. Increased Traffic Congestion: The proposed extension is likely to lead to increased traffic congestion, particularly around railway crossings. Many passengers may be unwilling to change trains at Howth Junction due to the inconvenience and the high likelihood of not securing a seat during peak periods. This reluctance to transfer could result in more people opting to drive, exacerbating traffic congestion in the area.
- 2. **Safety Concerns at Howth Junction**: The changeover at Howth Junction is already perceived as unsafe, particularly for vulnerable groups such as children. There was a disturbing incident last summer where a woman was kicked onto the tracks at Howth Junction, underscoring the risks associated with this station. Increasing the volume of passengers transferring at this location will only heighten these dangers, particularly for young commuters.
- 3. **Impact on Property and Commuting**: When purchasing property in Howth, many residents did so with the understanding that there would be a direct rail link to the Southside, facilitating easy access to family and work. The proposed changes will remove this direct connection, significantly reducing the convenience and safety of commuting. The need to transfer at Howth Junction, especially during busy periods, diminishes the appeal of using the DART service and may lead to more people opting to drive, further contributing to traffic and environmental issues.
- 4. Railway Crossings and Local Traffic: The extension of the DART service to Drogheda will necessitate more frequent closures of railway crossings to accommodate increased train traffic. This will disrupt local traffic flow and could lead to significant delays for residents, further increasing congestion and frustration.

In light of these concerns, I urge you to reconsider the proposed DART+ Coastal North extension and explore alternative solutions that would address these issues
