

Observation on a Strategic Infrastructure Application Case no 320164

My name is Lisa Cunningham and I am the owner of the above salon in 2 Boyd House, Harbour Road, Howth, Co. Dublin. I have been in business here for 26 years.

I am objecting to the proposed changes to our current Dart services to and from Howth. It will have a detrimental effect on my business, the coffee shop beside my shop Little Moo and all the other small businesses in the town that rely on people using the Dart.

I have lots of customers who come from Clontarf + Killester, some of them are old and have been coming to me for years because of the direct route to Howth. If they have to get off at Howth Junction and cross over to get a connecting dart it will be catastrophic as it has been noted that 90 % of the time the lifts there are broken. It is so unsafe also and a local myself I won't be getting off there when I need to go to town, I will drive!!

If my clients with kids are bringing their buggies with them to see me for their kids haircuts how are they to manage ???? HOWTH JUNCTION is NOT SAFE they will stop coming to me and go elsewhere that they don't have to change route .

All the local apartments that are currently being built on the peninsula were granted permission with one of the selling points of having a good Dart route direct to town !!! At least 800 new people will be in the new development {that's a small guide amount} whom a lot will be using the Dart to commute .lmagine the chaos with all that extra amount of people getting on and off every day , not to mention what it will be like if there's a problem with weather or an incident on the line !!!! Deluge comes to mind .

Now to the issue of traffic at Sutton Cross and at the Baldoyle junction ..You say the gates will be down up to 30 mins of every hour!

How possibly can we commute in and out to schools, businesses and general commuting around the peninsula efficiently. The traffic currently comes back up to Santa Sabina on a regular day, Sundays its even further up to Strand road on this side and back up as far as Offington on the other side Fire Engine or doctor or emergencies services will be put at huge risk of getting through. At school times the traffic backs up, lunch times, afternoon schools and then rush hour traffic. THEN theres the weekend Traffic jams, Sutton Cross will be at a standstill with these Dart implications.

The past few years more and more tourists have been coming to Howth as its advertised as a direct line out ,Tourism will be hit hugely if they have to change lines.

WE HAVE NO OTHER WAY IN + OUT

WE need a solution to traffic at Sutton cross NOT MORE traffic and hold ups ..
